Student Illness

We have been seeing cases of the flu at school. Please keep your child at home if he/she displays any of the following symptoms:

- Sore throat, vomiting, temperature over 37.5°C (99.5°F) or diarrhea
- Any signs of contagious diseases such as chicken pox, measles, mumps, etc.

Please also note that children should be kept at home for at least 48 hours (NEW) after all symptoms have subsided or after starting any antibiotic treatment and are free of fever. Everyone's cooperation is needed to ensure the health and safety of all the students at school. If a child displays a sore throat, vomiting, temperature over 37.5°C (99.5°F) or diarrhea at school, they will be sent home.

If a student is sent home with a sore throat, vomiting, temperature over 37.5°C (99.5°F) or diarrhea, they must remain at home the following day. (NEW)
