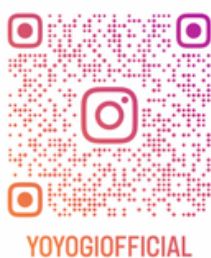

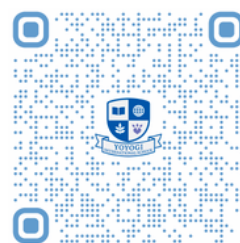
Grade 3 Trip to Miraikan

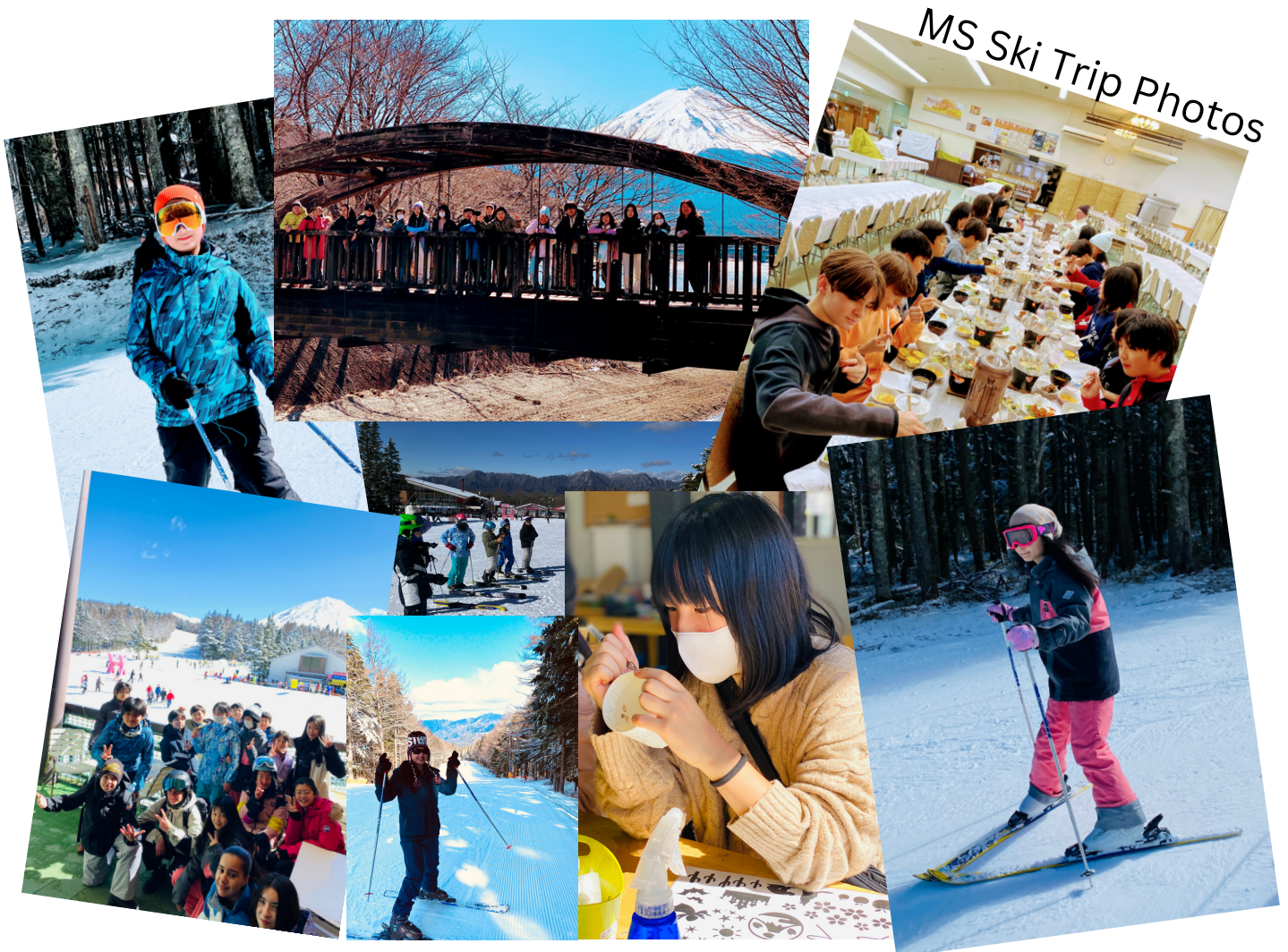
