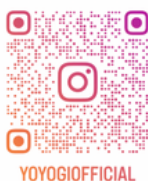

Class Size for 2025- 2026

With the addition of larger classrooms, we can increase classroom student capacity slightly. We still aim to keep class capacity well below Japan and International enrollment standards. Most classes will not approach the classroom capacity due to an increase of the number of classrooms available and new staff.

Maximum Class Size 2025-26

Grade	Max Student #s
G. K	Cap at 16
G. 1-5	Cap at 18
G. 6-8	Cap at 20

We are increasing our teaching and office staff by 15% next year to allow for more options and support for students. Our enrollment growth predictions for 2025-26 are steady with modest increases.



Library Purchase

We are preparing a significant library purchase for our students. Yoyogi will have its own K and Grade 1 focussed library. The new Jinnan Campus will have a large open library and will be able to house a larger collection. Purchases are being focused on our units of study, reflecting the cultures in our school and improving our Japanese collection.



Student Utensils Needed
