Summer Base Camp

Jinnan Campus and Youth Olympic Center

Base Camp runs seven weeks of our summer program from June 16 through August 1. We will change daily activities, trips and projects throughout the summer so campers returning for multiple weeks will see changes and something fresh.

8:30-11:30

Each day the students arrive directly to the Youth Memorial Olympic Center where we spend the morning in the gym with fun games and cooperative activities. We travel by bus back to the Jinnan campus for lunch. Some mornings in June, campers may choose to go to the Pony Park close by.

12:00-1:00

Students eat lunch at the new Jinnan Campus. Campers may choose to eat lunch from home or order their lunch through the catering service, Kiwi Kitchen

1:00-3:00

In the afternoon, students will have the opportunity to participate in activities of their choice. They will have the chance to socialize as they play games, create art, conduct STEM experiments, and participate in other staff-directed activities. Students will participate in an English language environment. New English Learners will be offered support.

3:15-4:45

After Hours Care is provided by school staff. Campers can play games, visit with friends or do some simple crafts while they wait for pick-up. There is an additional fee for this service and should be booked when registering.

Osaka EXPO Trip (Tuesday-Thursday)

Travelling campers meet our trained school staff at the Jinnan Campus by 8:30 am. Osaka EXPO campers will go to Tokyo Station by train and they will board the Shinkansen to travel to Osaka. We have booked am AirbNb for the stay under the supervision of male and female staff. Campers may be asked to share a room with another student. We have limited spaces available for child safety reasons.

Monday and Friday

Monday will prepare students for the trip and give them time to get to know each other. Details can be found on the Base Camp page. On Friday, campers will participate with the other day campers and have time to reflect on the EXPO Trip with the staff. Staff will share images and memories from the trip with families. The primary goal of all activities is to ensure safe and fun participation. All staff members have completed Child Safeguarding training and received formal teacher training. Students will be directly supervised 100% of the trip.

Monday and Tuesday

On Monday and Tuesday, campers will follow the Base Camp routines. Each day there will be a dedicated time for YMCA Camper to gather, discuss the trip procedures and rules so that we are safe on the trip. Students will also learn about the destination to get the most out of the experience and get to know the others on their trip. They will still participate in events and play with the rest of the campers.



YMCA Trip (Wednesday-Friday)

Travelling campers meet at the Youth Memorial Olympic Center by 8:30 am. YMCA Campers, along with their luggage, will travel to the venue by the school-owned bus. A combination of YMCA Camp Staff and Yoyogi IS Staff will supervise student activities over the three days. Food and Accommodation are covered in the camp fee.

Campers will return to Jinnan Campus by school bus on Friday afternoon.

















Camp Details

Lunch

Students can bring a packed lunch or place an order for lunch via Kiwi Kitchen. Please note that the school will not reheat or refrigerate students' lunch. Campers attending the Osak Trip and the YMCA Camps will be provided with meals while on the trip. Please inform the staff of any allergies before the camp.

Busses

Travelling campers meet at the same place (Youth Memorial Olympic Center) by 8:30 am. YMCA Campers will travel by school bus to the venue. Osaka EXPO campers will be transported to Tokoy Station will they will board the Shnkansen to trav le to Osaka.

Staff

The summer camps staff include Yoyogi International School teachers, student staff and formal staff at the facilities we visit. All Yoyogi IS Staff complete training for Child Safeguarding and safety.

Arrival and Pick-up

Please arrive by 8:30 at the Athletic Building of the Youth Olympic Center prepared for indoor play and activities. The end-of-day pick-up location will be at the Jinnan Campus at 15:00.

Extended Care

After hours care is provided by school staff at 15:15-16:45. Campers can play games, visit with friends or do some simple crafts while they wait. Sometimes staff will pay a short movie.

Facilities

Camps will use the Yoyogi IS campuses, Youth Olympic Center Gym, Yoyogi Stadium pool, Yoyogi Park and area as well as destinations for day trips with parent authorization.
