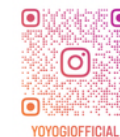
## OUR SUMMER PROGRAM

## SCHOOL BUS

## REGULAR COURSE

- Math and Science: Interactive lessons focusing on problem solving and scientific discovery.

- Sports: Physical activities and team-based exercises to promote health and collaboration at Olympic Center Gym (once a week)

## JAPANESE INTENSIVE COURSE
